magluto – to cook	sumayaw – to dance	magsulat – to write
magshopping – to shop	magmahal – to love	maglaba – to do the laundry
gumawa ng problema – to make/cause problems	manligaw – to court someone	
manloko – to fool someone	magpaasa ng iba – to raise the hopes of another	
magsalita ng Tagalog – to speak Filipino		

If you want to flatter others, just change the pronoun “ko” to the following:

Ko - I	natin – we
mo – you	ninyo – you (plural)
niya – he/she	nila – they

Ang galing mo magpaasa ng iba. – You raise the hopes of people so well.

Ang galing niya magsalita ng Tagalog. – She speaks Tagalog so well.

Ang galing ninyo manloko. - You guys sure know how to fool people.
