Sawa na *silá* sa... - They're sick and tired of...

Sawa na *si name* sa – *Name* is sick and tired of...

Nouns you can get sick and tired of:

Pag-ibig – love (*Sawa na ako sa pag-ibig!*)

Guerra – war (*Sawa ka na sa guerra!*)

Mcdó – McDonald's (*Sawa na sila sa McDonald's!*)

Buhay – life (*Sawa na sila sa buhay!*)

Mundo – the world (*Sawa na si Honeypurr sa mundo!*)

Mukha mo – your face (*Sawa na ako sa mukha mo!*)

Kaartehan mo – your fussiness (*Sawa na siya sa kaartehan mo!*)

Kapangitan niya – his ugliness (*Sawa na si Jhunjhun sa kapangitan niya!*)

-Jhunjuhn is sick and tired of his ugliness.

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States that you can get sick and tired of:

Pagiging sobrang galing – being so good (*Sawa na ako sa pagiging sobrang galing!*)

- I'm sick and tired of being so good.

Pagiging single – being single (*Sawa na si Juliebeth sa pagiging single! Gusto na niyang magtanan!*)

- Juliebeth is sick and tired of being single. She wants to elope!

Pagiging mataba – being fat (*Sawa na siya sa pagiging mataba! Gusto na niyang magpa-lipo!*)

- She's sick and tired of being fat! She wants to have liposuction!

Pagiging malungkot – being sad (*Sawa na ako sa pagiging malungkot.*)

- I'm sick and tired of being sad. *enter emo song of your choice*
