laki – big	liit – small	payat – thin	taba – fat
lapit – near	layo – far	baho – stinky	bango – fragrant
asim – sour	tamis – sweet	tangkad – tall	bansot – short (height)
tigas – hard	lambot – soft	haba – long	iksi – short (length)

For example

Ang laki naman! – That's so big!
Malaki iyan! - That's big!

Ang layo naman! – How far!!
Malayo iyan! – That's far!

Ang tamis ng halo-halo! – The halo-halo is so sweet!
Matamis ang halo-halo. – Halo-halo is sweet.

Ang baho! – How stinky!
Mabaho iyan. – That stinks.
