



Newbie Lesson: Taking a Taxi. Sige, Pasok.

“Taksi, taksi!” – Taxi! Taxi!
“Saan punta niyo?” – Where you going?
“Sa Airport” – To the airport.
“Sige, pasok.” – Sure, enter. Hop in.

Tambay Talk:

Saan – *Where?*

Punta (v) – *to go*

Niyo – 2nd person plural pronoun used to show respect (the singular pronoun is mo)

You can ask:

Saan punta *ko*? – Where am I going?

Saan punta *mo*? – Where are you going?

Saan punta *niyo*? – Where are you (plural/respect) going?

Saan punta *niya*? – Where is he/she going?

Saan punta *nila*? – Where are they going?

You can answer:

Sa *airport*. – To the airport.

Sa *eskwela*. – To the school.

Sa *tindahan*. – To the store.

Sa *sinehan*. – To the cinema.

Sa *banyo*. – To the bathroom.

Sa *kusina*. – To the kitchen.
