7. *Ok, so nandito si Rajah Sulayman, di ba? Dito siya nakatira? Paano pumasok yung mga espanyol?* – Ok, so Rajah Sulayman was here, right? He lived here? Then, how'd the Spanish come into play?

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8. *Noong pumasok yung Spanish times na, ano yung significance ng Intramuros sa Philippine Colonial history?* – When the Spanish times came in, what was the significance of Intramuros in the Philippine Colonial history?
9. *So, yung Spanish government at yung simbahang Katoliko?* – So, the Spanish government and the Roman Catholic Church?
10. *And lahat ito, nandito pa rin? Makikita pa rin?* - And all of these are still here? They can all still be seen?
11. *Gusto ko lang sabihin dito na dati sa intramuros ang daming mga eskwela, ang daming mga simbahan dito, pero nasunog sila noong WWII.* – I just want to mention that before, there were so many schools and churches here in Intramuros, but they all got burned down during World War II.
12. *Anong nangyari?* – What happened?
13. *Hindi ko alam yon ah!* – I didn't know that!
14. *Balita ko yung Ateneo, dito raw nagsimula sa Intramuros.* – I heard that the Ateneo began here in Intramuros.
15. *So, Ateneo, ito yung aming alma mater.* – Ateneo, this is our alma mater.
16. *Marami talagang universities ditto sa Intramuros, but aside from universities, ano pa ang pwedeng makita kung ako'y naglalakad-lakad dito sa Intramuros?* – There are a lot of universities here in Intramuros, but aside from universities, what else can I see if I walk around Intramuros?
17. *Kung gusto niyong malaman pa ang buhay ni Jose Rizal, pwede kayong pumunta dito sa Fort Santiago, may museo para sa kanya dito.* – if you want to know more about the life of Jose Rizal, you can go to Fort Santiago, there's a museum dedicated to him there.

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18. *And I think, yung totoong Mi Ultimo Adios, andoon rin.* - And I think, the real copy of “Mi Ultimo Adios” is there as well.

19. *May nabalitaan ako dati, sinabi sa amin ng History Teacher namin, na yung mga canyon sa Intramuros, naka-point raw sa Binondo.*

- I also heard before, our history teacher told us that the cannons in Intramuros are all pointed towards Binondo.

20. *Anong masasabi natin sa ating mga kapatid na Kano?*

- So, what can we say about our America brothers?
