I. May Wi-Fi ba dito?

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- **May Wi-Fi ba** [Is there Wi-Fi] **dito** [here]?
 - Alternate: **Mayroon bang Wi-Fi dito?**
 - **Mayroon** [contraction: **May**] – have, existence, presence. It is the “**ba**” that makes it “Is there?”:
 - Mayroon** – there is, existence, presence of something
 - Mayroon ba?** – Is there [something]?
- **May _____ ba dito?** – Is there a _____ here?
 - Useful for asking if something is present or available in the location or venue

You can also try: Filipino Phrase [root word] – English meaning

<i>May banyo ba dito?</i> [<i>banyo {restroom}</i>]	Is there a restroom here?
<i>May atm ba dito?</i> [<i>atm {auto-teller-machine}</i>]	Is there an atm here?
<i>May kainan ba dito?</i> [<i>kainan {place to eat}</i>]	Is there a place to eat here?
<i>May telepono ba dito?</i> [<i>telepono {tele/payphone}</i>]	Is there a telephone here?
<i>May mga taxi ba dito?</i> [<i>taxi {taxi}</i>]	Are there taxis here?
<i>May bayad ba dito?</i> [<i>bayad {payment}</i>]	Is there a fee to be in this place?
<i>May nakaupo ba dito?</i> [<i>upo{sit}</i>]	Is there someone sitting here?
