- I. May joke ako!
 - may – “to have”
 - ako – “I”
 - Sentence structure: “May ____ ako” ~ “I have _____”
 - Sample nouns: Insert Word to the chunk “May ____ ako.”

Word	Meaning	Translation
Sikreto	Secret	I have a secret.
Sasabihin	Something to tell	I have something to tell.
Pamasahe	Fare (public transportation)	I have cab/bus/train/jeepney fare.
Pagkain	Food	I have food.
Kati	(an) itch	I have an itch.
Alam	Know	I know something.
Sakit	Sickness/disease	I’m sick.
Kailangan	need	I have a need. / I need something.
Kaaway	enemy	I have an enemy.
Panahon	time	I have time.
Pakialam	concern	This concerns me. / I care.

II. Anong tawag sa taong nasagasaan ng pison?

- Anong tawag – chunk “What do you call (?)”
- Sa taong – chunk “a person”, “tao” means person. The stress is in the first syllable “ta-“.
 - Not to be confused with “sa taong” meaning “in the year ____”.
 - “Taon,” the stress is on the second syllable “-on” and means “year”.
- Nasagasaan – “to get run over”
- Pison – steamroller

III. Tanga

- Means “stupid”

IV. “Joke Joke Joke!”

- Works 100% of the time 36% of the time.
